Uniform - all students:

We expect all students to wear their uniform with pride, whether they are in school or outside in the community as they travel to and from the school.

Years 7-11: UCS uniform with blazer

- ☐ Plain white collared shirt/blouse to be tucked inside of trousers or skirt.
- ☐ Plain black trousers & plain black pleated skirts. Skirts must be an appropriate length (visible below the blazer).
- Plain black tights with no pattern.
- ☐ University Collegiate School tie.
- ☐ University Collegiate School blazer.
- Sensible black polishable footwear without markings or other colours. Footwear should be full and cover the whole foot with a sturdy sole for health and safety reasons.
- ☐ Headscarves/hijab/headwear worn for religious reasons must be black.
- Stud earrings only. One set in the ears and one stud in the nose allowed. No other piercing type are permitted.

PE kit:

- UCS polo shirt.
- UCS shorts/skort, plain black leggings or tracksuit bottoms.
- ☐ UCS sports long sleeve outdoor top.
- Suitable training shoes must be worn.
- UCS football socks and football boots to be worn, when required.
- ☐ Waterproofs optional.
- Any under layers on show must be black.

Please Note:

- Coats or jackets, caps or hats are NOT to be worn in the building.
- □ No jumpers and no hoodies are to be worn.
- Jeans, tracksuit bottoms, leggings or jeggings are NOT permitted.
- No other jewellery is permitted. This includes rings and bracelets.
- Nail polish, acrylic or false nails are not permitted. False eye lashes will need to be removed.
- Extreme hair colours, styles or extensions are not permitted.
- Subtle, natural looking make-up is permitted. The Headteacher (or those with delegated responsibility) reserves the right to instruct the removal of make-up should it be deemed unacceptable.
- If not removed, coats and jewellery will be confiscated by all staff.
- Mobile phones should be switched off and out of sight once students are on school grounds. If students are seen with a mobile phone, it will be confiscated by staff.

Students who do not have the correct uniform will be spoken with.

Form tutors will remind students of uniform expectations regularly.

We will consider students as individuals and support, where needed, will be provided.

Students who do not follow the uniform instructions will be sanctioned using the school behaviour policy.
